On behalf of the Ottawa Knights of Columbus Council 1757, we want to thank everyone who contributed to the Knights of Columbus Ultrasound Initiative Campaign. Through the love of Christ, and through your generous donations, we are able to reach out and serve the women in our community. We believe that every good and perfect gift comes from above and therefore we promise to uphold your gift with the utmost respect. Ultrasound is our window into the womb and the most powerful way to give the Heartbeat Clients a revelation about the beautiful life they are nurturing. You have directly impacted the lives of generations by helping sponsor an ultrasound machine.

Below is a summary of what we have accomplished together and the impact we pray it will have through the efforts of the Heartbeat Facilities in years to come.

Six Knights of Columbus Councils: Delphos, Columbus Grove, Kalida, Lima, Ottawa, and Ottoville met and decided to approach their pastors to see if the Knights could make an announcement in their respective parishes to inform their parishioners concerning the urgent need for a new ultrasound machine at the Heartbeat of Lima facility. The monies raised were to be placed in an account, K of C Ultrasound Project, designated for heartbeat of Lima.

This recent Knights of Columbus Ultrasound Initiative Campaign to replace the failing ultrasound machine at a Heartbeat of Lima facility was extremely successful. The campaign raised a total of \$57,952.75. Of that amount the parishes of Sts. Peter & Paul, St. John's, Leipsic St. Mary's, Holy Family, St. Nicholas, Sacred Heart, St. Paul's, and Holgate St. Mary's raised a total of \$18,281.72. This was only made possible because of your tremendous generosity!

Since the onset of the Knights of Columbus Ultrasound Initiative, over 500 ultrasounds have been placed in Pro-Life Facilities in all 50 states. This impact computes to 1000 babies are saved each week!
