Dear Parishioners,



We have made it to the most sacred week of the entire Church year. Holy Week begins today with Palm Sunday and the reading of the Passion and continues with many significant liturgies throughout the week. On Tuesday, Bishop Thomas will gather with priests, deacons, consecrated religious, and lay faithful from across the Diocese of Toledo at the cathedral for the annual Chrism Mass. It is at this special liturgy that the Oil of Catechumens (used in the baptism of infants and before the baptism of adults) and the Oil of the Sick (used in Anointing of the Sick) are blessed while the Sacred Chrism (used in the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and holy orders) is consecrated. Priests also renew their priestly promises at this Mass and celebrate the gift of their vocation with a special luncheon afterwards with Bishop Thomas and the permanent deacons and seminarians of our diocese.

On Wednesday at 7:30 pm, the cathedral will also host a Tenebrae service with Evening Prayer. Tenebrae (which means “darkness” in Latin) is a celebration where candles are progressively extinguished as the prayer service continues until the entire church is left in darkness. Part of the symbolism is the mourning of Christ’s death. Each year, three priests are invited to chant a section of the Book of Lamentations. Fr. Austin Ammaniti of Paulding Divine Mercy, Fr. Joseph Mominee of Maumee St. Joseph, and I will do these chants (we did them last year and will do them again next year as part of our three year term). Anyone who would like to is welcome to attend.

On Holy Thursday, we will celebrate the Evening Mass of the Lord’s Supper at each parish which marks Jesus giving us the gift of the priesthood and the gift of the Eucharist. The Gospel reading includes Jesus’ command after He washes his disciples feet: “as I have done for you, you should also do” (John 13:15, NABRE). At the conclusion of Mass, a procession will take place with the Eucharist to an altar of repose. Everyone is invited to remain in adoration before the altar of repose as desired until 10:00 pm.

On Good Friday, Morning Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours will be prayed at 8:45 am at St. Nicholas. Stations of the Cross will precede the Celebration of the Lord’s Passion at each church which includes the veneration of the Cross. It is a day where the Church even fasts from celebrating Mass. It is a day of meditating on and reflecting on what Jesus did for us. On Holy Saturday, Morning Prayer will be prayed at 8:45 am at St. Nicholas. Holy Saturday is a day when “the Church waits at the Lord’s tomb in prayer and fasting, meditating on his Passion and Death and on his Descent into Hell, and awaiting his Resurrection” (*Roman Missal*, Holy Saturday, n. 1). It is also a day when the Church fasts from even the celebration of the Mass until the Easter Vigil.

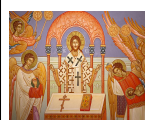
The Easter Vigil is such a beautiful celebration with readings that tell the story of our salvation, the Exultet (a chant near the beginning of the Mass), and the celebration of baptism, confirmation, and first Holy Communion for many of those entering the Catholic Church around the world. Although we do not have anyone becoming Catholic at our Easter Vigil this year, we will be united in prayer on this most sacred night. Holy Week culminates with the celebration of Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord where we will celebrate with joy Christ’s glorious rising from the dead, something that gives us the hope of doing the same after our death.

What a truly holy, sacred, and special week this will be. May we enter into the mysteries of this Holy Week, walking with Jesus through the trials and sorrows of His Passion to His glorious Resurrection.

**FASTING & ABSTINENCE (from the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops):** Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

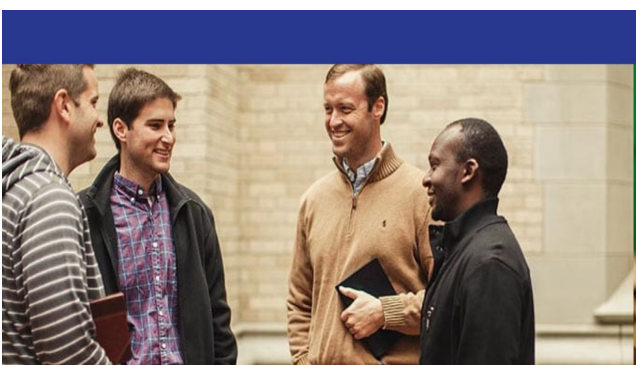

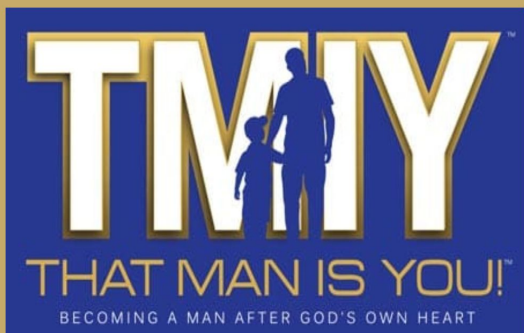
