

Code of Conduct: Class Virtues and Consequences for PSR and Youth Nights

Class Virtues:

1. **FAITH:** We believe in Christ Jesus and recognize that God is present everywhere we go and in every person we encounter.
2. **HOPE:** We put our hope in Jesus. Trusting His Church and following His Commandments will lead us to be hopeful. Remember the Golden Rule: Do unto others as I would have them do unto me.
3. **LOVE:** Every person has something to offer to the good of others and to the overall success of everything that happens during PSR. We love others and ourselves when we follow the rules. We also need to have a respect for materials being used during PSR.
4. More Virtues listed below

Consequences:

1. Verbal Warning
2. Accountability/Oops Form signed by Parents/Guardian and turned back in.
3. 2nd Accountability/Oops Form signed by Parents/Guardian and turned back in.
4. A written apology letter to the Catechist (teacher). A phone call to the Parents/Guardian to talk about a plan going forward.
5. If behavior still continues a meeting with me, my Parents/Guardian, Teacher, CRE and the Pastor will be scheduled

<u>Behaviors of VICE</u>	<u>Behaviors of VIRTUE</u>
Pride: Giving glory and praise to yourself.	HUMILITY: Giving all glory and credit to God.
Envy: Desiring what others have.	ADMIRATION: Doing what is right for another person.
Sloth: Lack of doing work or being active.	ZEAL: Enthusiasm, putting forth your best effort.
Greed: Desiring wealth or possessions over love of others.	GENEROSITY: Giving without expecting anything in return.
Wrath: Hostile emotions or even anger toward another.	FORGIVENESS: To pardon someone for a wrong, without expecting something in return.
Gluttony: Overindulging in food, drink or other worldly pleasures.	ASCETICISM: Self-discipline, detaching from worldly attachments.
Lust: A selfish act of using another person.	CHASTITY: We are called to love one another and respect each other.

The 10 Commandments: The Virtues that help us to not sin.

- 1. I AM THE LORD THY GOD: THOU SHALT NOT HAVE STRANGE GODS BEFORE ME. HUMILITY**
 - Satan tempts you through **Pride** to act arrogant and boastful, thinking that our own wisdom is better than the wisdom of the Catholic Church. God wants you to only worship him, because worship of other things or people will not lead us to the true love that he has in store for you.
- 2. THOU SHALT NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD THY GOD IN VAIN. ADMIRATION**
 - Satan tempts you through **Envy** to use God's name and others in vain. Envy wants you to be jealous, so you talk bad about others and God. Admiration can give us the filter for which you can choose to look at others through the lens of Christ, who you should have ultimate Admiration and Reverence for.
- 3. KEEP THE SABBATH HOLY. HUMILITY**
 - Satan tempts you through **Pride** to forgo your obligations out of laziness or business. Practicing the virtue of Humility can help you overcome Pride and make room for you to spend more time with God.
- 4. HONOUR THY FATHER AND THY MOTHER. ZEAL**
 - Satan tempts you through **Sloth** to procrastinate and be lazy, so you are distracted from your obligations. You need to spend time with your parents and listen to their wisdom and do as they command.
- 5. THOU SHALT NOT KILL. FORGIVENESS**
 - Satan tempts you through **Wrath**, which is anger and rage. Practicing forgiving those that sin against you, will lead to feelings of love and happiness in your heart.
- 6. THOU SHALT NOT COMMIT ADULTERY. CHASTITY**
 - Satan tempts you through **Lust**. This commandment is an adult sin. The virtue of Chastity is for all of us to practice, because it calls you to respect and love others.
- 7. THOU SHALT NOT STEAL. ASCETICISM**
 - Satan tempts you through **Gluttony** and selfishness. This sin leaves you always wanting more. The virtue of Asceticism will help in overcoming this temptation through discipline. Discipline can help your heart feel satisfied and at peace..
- 8. THOU SHALT NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST THY NEIGHBOR. ADMIRATION**
 - Satan tempts you to lie about others, through **Envy**. Having Admiration for others will help us to treat others in love.
- 9. THOU SHALT NOT COVET THY NEIGHBOR'S WIFE. GENEROSITY**
- 10. THOU SHALT NOT COVET THY NEIGHBOR'S GOODS.**
 - Satan tempts you through **Greed**, to want things that don't belong to you, making you feel shameful.
 - Satan tempts you through **Greed** to be selfish and have a want for things instead of the love of others. Generosity will help you love in God's order of goodness.
