Dear Parishioners,

We are honored and blessed to be hosting today the Baccalaureate Mass for the Miller City-New Cleveland High School Class of 2026. So many years of hard work and dedication have led to this upcoming moment of graduating high school on Friday and heading on to the next part of life's journey. Whether the next step is to attend college, enter the workforce, serve in the military, or even to pursue missionary work or a religious vocation, may our graduates always remain deeply rooted in Christ and allow Him to lead them to lives of holiness, joy, and virtue and, ultimately, to heaven.



Also, Happy Mother's Day to all mothers of our parishes! I hope that today is one filled with gratitude for the gift of motherhood that God has given you. Today, we honor our mothers, both living and deceased, and can especially pray for them. For those whose mothers have passed from this world, it can be a good day, too, to remember the memories you have shared with her, to thank God for them, and to pray for her eternal rest. May the Lord bless all of the mothers of our parishes as they seek to model themselves after our Blessed Mother Mary, the mother of Jesus and our spiritual mother.

It was a blessing for me to gather with Bishop Thomas and the priests of the Diocese of Toledo last Wednesday for the annual Priests' Jubilee Celebration. We had a nice Mass at St. Ignatius in Oregon, OH with dinner afterwards. I had the chance to sit with three of the Jubilarians at the meal including Fr. Steve Blum, who I lived with in Delphos for three years, and Fr. David Ritchie, the pastor of Columbus Grove St. Anthony and the former dean of our deanery. Fr. Steve Schroeder, our former pastor, and Fr. John Stites, a senior status priest who occasionally helps out with confessions and Masses in our parishes, and Fr. Tom Oedy, the brother of St. Nicholas parishioner Bill Oedy, were also honored (the full list is on page 7 of the bulletin). Overall, there were 590 years of priesthood represented by the 13 priests celebrating jubilees. It is an impressive witness to living out the vocation to the priesthood, and I am grateful for their many years of generous service to God and to His people,

Speaking of anniversary celebrations, we will mark special days for our parishes in the next week or so. On Thursday, May 14, we will celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of St. Nicholas Church which was dedicated on that day in the year 1919. The dedication in 1919 took place after the previous church building was severely damaged by a tornado in 1918. The original church building of St. Nicholas Parish was dedicated in 1888. On Monday, May 18, we will celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of Holy Family Church which was dedicated in 1916. The current church is the second church with the original one being dedicated in 1862. Both of these anniversary feast days have the rank of "solemnity" which is the highest ranking feast day in the Church. We will celebrate these anniversaries with special Masses on those days as we give thanks to God for our beautiful houses of worship. Please note, too, that due to May 14 falling on a Thursday, there will be no confessions or Mass at Holy Family on that day.

May the Lord continue to bless and guide us here at St. Nicholas and Holy Family Parishes, and may He pour out His abundant blessings on the Class of 2026 as they prepare for graduation on Friday.
