Dear Parishioners,

We have reached the last week of school for so many of our members who are students, teachers, or school staff. I hope this school year has been one filled with many blessings and the opportunity to grow personally, intellectually, and especially spiritually. Congratulations to the Class of 2026, and may God's blessings be with you in your future endeavors. As I mentioned in my homily for Baccalaureate Mass, may you always know that God will be with you to give you strength and guidance in the future.



Speaking of school, I felt somewhat like a student again these past five weeks. Our parish hosted five training sessions on the past five Tuesdays as part of a new initiative from Live Jesus Ministries (LJM). Live Jesus is a new approach to forming our youth in the faith that is based on a mentorship model rather than a classroom model. It is fully endorsed by Bishop Thomas and the Diocese of Toledo and is provided free of charge to any parish in the diocese who desires it. Locally, Ottawa Sts. Peter and Paul Parish has already had two sets of these 5-week formation sessions (with another one taking place this summer) while around 750 mentors, I believe, from around the diocese have already been trained.

Live Jesus Ministries desires that the pastor undergo this formation along with potential adult mentors for our youth. The reason for this is so that the pastor is fully behind this youth ministry approach, is informed, and can help promote it in the parish. I can say that I am wholeheartedly behind our pursuit of the Live Jesus model and am excited to see the fruit it will bring in our parishes. Already these past three years, we have adopted a discipleship/mentor model for our high school youth nights which has gone very well. We even had some youth ask for *more* youth nights this year after the schedule had ended so that they could meet again in their small groups.

One book that was given to us in the training entitled *One Disciple at a Time* by Everett Fritz explains part of the reason that youth have a desire for this model today. In years past, youth (and society at large) sought community experiences by physically going to a large event like a social (which is why large social events were popular in youth ministry in the not-so-distant past). However, now, our society is much different with the existence of the internet, cell phones, and social media. Youth are often fully connected to people from all over the world nearly 24/7. What they crave and are very hungry for are more personal, intimate relationships in a smaller setting. Live Jesus Ministries provides this by having an adult mentor walk with a small group of ideally 3-6 students. The mentor meets with the youth on a regular basis to pray with them, check in on how it is going in living out their faith, helping them to grow as a committed disciple of Christ, and suggesting concrete steps for them to grow in their relationship with God.

The idea behind this model is that there are different stages of becoming a disciple. Often in the Church today, we assume that a student in PSR already has a personal relationship with Christ and is committed to their faith. Yet sadly, statistics show that this is often not the case. John Trabbic, the LJM executive director, mentioned that of those Catholics ages 10-24, 80% will leave the Catholic faith. This is an awful statistic, but I think it highlights the dire need that the Church has to meet the needs of our current time in history shaped by our modern secular culture. I truly believe that Live Jesus Ministries and this discipleship approach to passing on the faith is part of the Holy Spirit's answer to this problem. It is also a model based on how Jesus Himself made disciples: He had a small group of twelve that he formed and an even smaller group of just three (Peter, James, and John) that he especially invested Himself in. The result of Jesus especially focusing on forming just a few disciples has led to the over 2 billion followers of Christ in the world today.

I am excited about our adoption of Live Jesus in our parishes. The beauty of it is that adults who live out their faith can help the younger generations on their own journey. Often, the leader of such groups gets just as much out of the group as those who are a part of it (I can attest to this with my priesthood discernment group that I have led the past two years). Currently, we have a group of around 18 or so adult mentors who lead high school groups, but the desire is for even more. I get a sense that there are many more good candidates for adult mentors in our parishes to walk with the youth in a small group. We hope to have another 5-week training session sometime this year.

May the Lord bless our efforts to evangelize and disciple our youth through Live Jesus Ministries, and may the Holy Spirit raise up mentors for our youth to witness the faith to them and help them love the Lord and their Catholic faith.

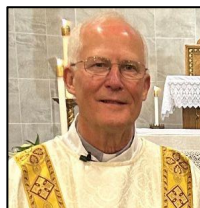

# TRANSITIONAL DIACONATE ORDINATION

Deacon Evan Sekerak was ordained to the transitional diaconate on Saturday, May 16, 2026. Meet the newest transitional deacon of the Diocese of Toledo!



## Deacon Evan Sekerak

My name is Evan Sekerak, from St. Aloysius in Bowling Green. Growing up, my parents showed my younger sister, brother, and me that faith is always a priority no matter where the military moved us, including the gift of now twenty years of Catholic education. Everywhere we lived, we found ourselves at home by jumping wholly into parish life. My father's last assignment brought us back to Ohio, our families' home and Bowling Green, where it began. Here, my thoughts about the priesthood and my faith in general took more shape through the diocese's discernment groups and retreats and attending ordinations since 2006.

I attended Cardinal Stritch Catholic High School and then made the 1,000+ mile trip to the University of Mary in North Dakota to study engineering. After a year, I switched my major to philosophy as God's call to enter the seminary became clearer. In the spring of 2020, I applied and was accepted to enter the seminary for the Diocese of Toledo. I spent two years at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit before arriving to my current home at Mount St. Mary's in Cincinnati.

The example of holiness and presence of the priests from all the places we lived was a great witness that I believe planted the seeds of my vocation. So many were encouraging and took time from their busy days to foster my prayer, discernment, and zeal. I am also grateful for the prayers and support from so many across the diocese where I have served and who I have not yet met. Please continue to pray for all of our seminarians as we discern and are formed to be the men and priests to make Christ present as He so wishes to be.
