PASTOR'S NOTE

Happy Father's Day to all of the fathers of our parishioners! May today provide them with the opportunity to give thanks to God for the great gift of their call to be a living image of God the Father to their children. May we especially pray for our fathers today, both those living and those who have gone before us.

Speaking of fathers, the spiritual fathers of the Diocese of Toledo will be gathering this week for our biennial priest convocation in Huron, Ohio. We will have time for prayer, meals together, recreation, and also talks from Rhonda Gruenewald who will speak to us about creating a culture of promoting vocations in our parishes. I am looking forward to this upcoming week. Since this convocation is only for diocesan priests, our two neighboring Precious Blood parishes (Ottawa Saints Peter and Paul and Glandorf St. John the Baptist) are good options for those who would like to attend daily Mass while the diocesan priests are away. At the end of this week on Saturday, June 27, there will be the priesthood ordination of Deacon Andrew Messer. Since he is the only person in his ordination class and since the cathedral is currently under renovation, he will be ordained at his home parish of St. Joan of Arc in Toledo. I am looking forward to concelebrating this special Mass and welcoming a new priest of our diocese.

Speaking of vocations, my young women's discernment group has been going well so far. We have eight young women part of the group who are open to learning more about a possible vocation to religious life. We are meeting around once a week this summer, and I hope it will be a helpful experience for them as they pray and consider what God is calling them to in life. Please pray for the Lord's blessings upon those in this discernment group and for me as I seek to guide them on their vocational journey.

Also, Holy Family Parishioners may have noticed recently the new landscaping on the church grounds. It turned out very well, and I am grateful for the good work that our Landscaping Committee has done in planning and coordinating this important project. Thanks also to the many parishioners who have made donations. These gifts are greatly appreciated.

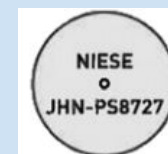

Summer hrs: Tues, Thursdays 9-12. Note: Monetary gifts are also welcome. Please place all the items in the clearly marked boxes provided in the entryway of St. Nicholas Church by Tuesday, June 30th and no later. If after that date, please deliver over to Holy Family Church. Thank you. (Holy Family Parish will be collecting items during the month of July).

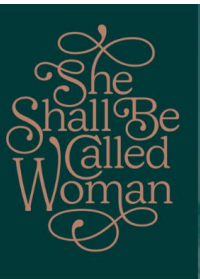
