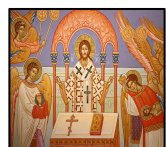
Congratulations, also, to all of our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who were commissioned for their new two-year term last weekend. All of them completed an enrichment session before their commissioning to help prepare them for this important ministry. They have the profound privilege of giving the Body and Blood Christ to their brothers and sisters. May they always carry out this ministry with reverence and love and realize the great gift that we have in the Eucharist.

Also, I mentioned in my homily last weekend about the website of Eucharistic miracles that St. Carlo Acutis made back in the early 2000s. It has over 100 Vatican-approved Eucharistic miracles like the miracle at Santarém, Portugal which my pilgrimage group had the privilege to see on our trip last October.

Also, this past week on Thursday, June 11, the Bishops of the United States consecrated our country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus during their biannual general assembly. This is in connection with the celebration of our country's semiquincentennial or 250th anniversary of its founding. The month of June is traditionally known as the month of the Sacred Heart (the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is always on the Friday after Corpus Christi Sunday and so almost always falls in the month of June). It is a beautiful devotion that reminds us of Jesus' profound love for us. Actually, this feast day has special significance for Sister Grace and her religious order as their official title is the Carmelite Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Los Angeles.

May this month of June be a reminder of the profound love that Jesus has for us, Jesus who is truly present in the Eucharist. As we prepare to mark the 250th birthday of America in the coming weeks, we also entrust our country to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and pray for God's blessings upon her, that more and more, our hearts may be united with His Sacred Heart.

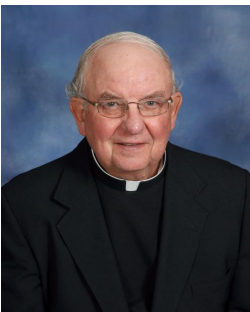

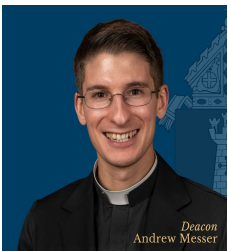

Summer hrs: Tues, Thursdays 9-12. Note: Monetary gifts are also welcome. Please place all the items in the clearly marked boxes provided in the entryway of St. Nicholas Church by Tuesday, June 30th and no later. If after that date, please deliver over to Holy Family Church. Thank you. (Holy Family Parish will be collecting items during the month of July).

**REVEREND JOHN R. LAUDICK:** Reverend John R. Laudick, Senior Status Priest of the Diocese of Toledo, died on Wednesday, May 27, 2026. Father Jack was a graduate of Sts. Peter and Paul High School, Ottawa, attended St. Gregory Seminary and was a graduate of Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Cincinnati. He was ordained to the Catholic priesthood at Holy Rosary Cathedral in Toledo on May 30, 1964.

Throughout his years of priestly ministry in the Toledo Diocese, Father Jack served in numerous parishes, including as pastor of St. John Parish in Lima in the 1980s. Please remember him in your prayers. *Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May his soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.*
