Dear Parishioners,

What a blessed time it was at our annual St. Nicholas and Holy Family Parishes Family Fun Day. Despite the rain, many were able to join us for some good food, games, and fellowship. We had a three-legged race, tug of war, gaga ball, and soccer that the kids enjoyed. We also had a 28-person corn hole tournament with high school students Evie Deitering and Callie Tobe as our championship team! They played some great games, and it was fun to watch. My teammate, Cruz Schroeder, and I made a valiant effort but we ended up losing to the team that was tournament runner-up: Colton Erford and Owen Recker.



I appreciate the *many* volunteers who helped in so many ways to make the day possible. From those who set up for the day to those who helped with tear-down and to everyone in between, your volunteering of your time is greatly appreciated. Thanks especially to Kira Niese, our Youth and Family Minister, who did an excellent job in planning and coordinating this event for our parishes. I appreciate her efforts to organize this enjoyable day.

Last Monday, I had the opportunity to attend another nice event; it was the annual priests' picnic with Bishop Thomas in Toledo. Usually the event takes place outside of the episcopal residence, but this year, it was held in the Rosary Cathedral School gymnasium due to inclement weather. I enjoyed spending time with my brother priests and catching up with them. I had the chance to talk quite a bit with Fr. Joe Szybka who was the pastor of my home parish (Tiffin St. Joseph) during my college and seminary years and who was an immense support to me in my journey to the priesthood. He has a great love for supporting vocations, and I feel like his witness and example is a big reason why promoting vocations is something that I highly value as well.

After our picnic meal, Bishop Thomas and Fr. Nathan Bockrath (the former pastor of Kalida St. Michael and the current rector of the cathedral) took us over to the cathedral which is currently being renovated. I found it very inspiring to see. The tabernacle has been moved back to its original location in the center of the sanctuary (it had been in the baptistry on the side of the church) while the crucifix has returned to above the tabernacle. A new main altar will be built in the sanctuary on a higher level which will help those attending Mass to see the altar from various parts of the church. The original cathedra (bishop's chair) will once again be used and will be placed in the side of the sanctuary. The choir will also be moved back to the choir loft on the side of the sanctuary. Overall, it is returning many things to their original location. A new addition, though, will be the five luminous mysteries of the rosary in beautiful mosaics that will be in the ceiling of the vestibule at the front entrance to the cathedral. I am very excited to see how the renovation will turn out. The project is expected to be completed in October with the dedication scheduled for 3:00 pm on Sunday, November 1. Bishop Thomas is hoping to have at least one person from every parish in the diocese attend this special dedication celebration.

This Wednesday and Thursday, I will be returning to the Rosary Cathedral campus for a leadership training that the diocese is sponsoring for a small group of priests who are pastors. I am looking forward to attending and hope it will be an opportunity for me and the other participants to grow in our leadership skills.

May you have a blessed Labor Day on Monday, and may it be an opportunity to thank God for the gift of labor that allows us to glorify God through our work.

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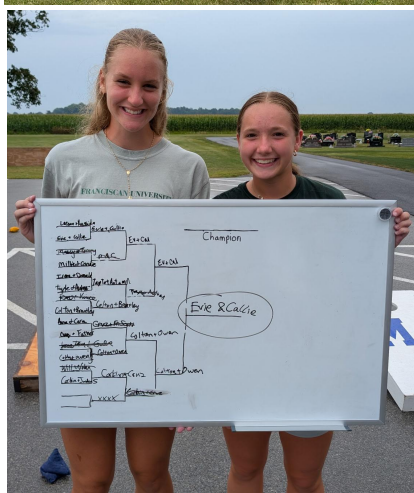

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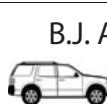
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
