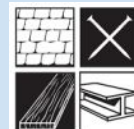

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to share with you an update regarding our Parish Staff. Recently, Moriah Inkrott, our Youth and Young Adult Minister, submitted her letter of resignation. Moriah is due to give birth in January and strongly desires to be a stay-at-home mother. While it is sad for our Parish Staff, youth, and young adults, it is a great joy for Moriah to be able to fulfill this dream that she has. Moriah has done such an excellent job in her role on the Parish Staff since June of last year. She has a gift for ministry, relating to others, and is so passionate about her Catholic faith. Moriah has a deep love for the Lord that is so evident to those who meet her. For me personally, it has been such a privilege to see how she has grown in her journey with the Lord since I met her three years ago before she was Catholic. I also had the privilege to receive her into the Church, confirm her, and administer to her her First Holy Communion back on Holy Family Sunday in 2024. In January 2025, I also celebrated her wedding with her husband, Joshua Inkrott. Moriah has been such a gift to us at St. Nicholas and Holy Family Parishes, and I am grateful that she said "yes" to the Lord in fulfilling her role as Youth and Young Adult Minister.



Moriah's last day on the Parish Staff will be around October 29. With her resignation, we are also beginning a job search to find a replacement for her role. A position description can be found on our parish website. The deadline to apply for this Youth & Young Adult Minister position is Monday, September 28. A cover letter and resume can be sent to our Administrative Assistant, Rose Inkrott, at parishoffice@stnicholasholyfamily.org. We hope to have a new Youth and Young Adult Minister by the end of October.

Also, I would like to let you know about an evaluation of me that will be taking place in the next few weeks. During the last year of a pastor's term in the Diocese of Toledo, he is evaluated by the Parish Staff/Parish Leadership and 40-60 randomly selected parishioners of his parishes. The priest also completes a self-evaluation as well. The evaluation is completed online, and a link to the survey is emailed to those selected parishioners directly by a Parish Staff member. Since this is the sixth year of my six year term, I am undergoing this evaluation now. The evaluation results are given to both the priest being evaluated and to the Priest Personnel Board (who recommends to the Bishop which priests should be assigned to the different parishes in our diocese). Overall, the evaluation is done to affirm the priest's ministry, identify areas for his continued growth, and to assist the Priest Personnel Board in making its recommendation to the Bishop regarding the priest's next pastoral assignment. Although I am completing a six-year term in June 30, 2027, I am eligible to be renewed for an additional six year term.

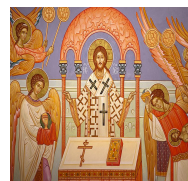

Perhaps today is a great day to especially remember them in our prayers, those who are living and those deceased.

May the Lord bless all grandparents and elderly in our parishes, and may we always love, honor, respect, and learn from them as they model God's tender love for us.

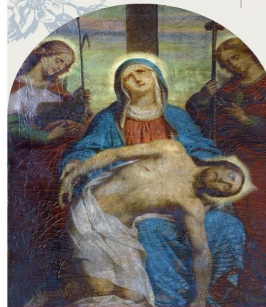

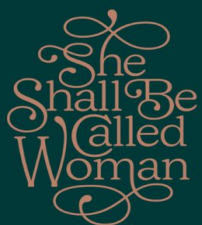

WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY:

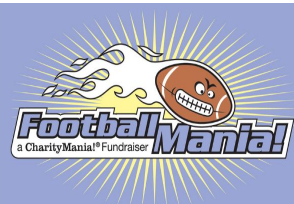
The U.S. bishops have approved the transfer of the

celebration of World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in the U.S. to the **first weekend after Labor Day (September 12 and 13, 2026)** to coincide with **National Grandparents (and the Elderly) Day in the United States** as many local communities, schools, and parishes have celebrated for some time. In 2021, Pope Francis established the **celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly** on the fourth Sunday of July, near the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus (July 26). **The theme for the 2026 celebration selected by the pope is "I will never forget you" (cf. Isaiah 49:5).** This theme reminds us that God's unwavering love is the ultimate answer to the isolation and neglect so often experienced by the elderly. It brings comfort and hope, assuring us that the Lord knows each of us personally, forgets no one, and loves us unconditionally, even through the frailties of old age.
